The Gib&rsquo;Sea 84&nbsp;forward cabin has a V-berths that convert using an infill into a comfortable double bed, surrounded by lockers and shelving, and typically topped with an opening deck hatch for ventilation.
The Saloon has two bench settees (port and starboard) that can be used as single berths. Both berths have Leecloths fitted. A folding table in the middle makes social meals easy. It has a Radio/Bluetooth Player and a Triclicks cabin heater fitted.
The Aft Cabin (Starboard):
Strong> Offers an enclosed double berth, though headroom and shoulder space can feel tight under the cockpit&mdash;particularly for broader or taller individuals.
The Galley is compact but functional, usually equipped with a Neptune double-burner gas hob and grill. It includes one sinkwith cold water, an icebox, plus ample storage cupboards. There is also a standalone 12V fridge included.
