2016 Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 41DS, designed by Philippe Briand, offering a well-balanced blend of performance, comfort and straightforward handling. Built in 2016 and launched the same year, she has been carefully maintained by her original owner and thoughtfully equipped for extended cruising. Currently ashore in Cleopatra Marina, Greece, she presents in clean and well-kept condition, ready for the coming season.

Her twin-wheel cockpit provides excellent space for relaxing at anchor or dining in harbour, with teak seating, cockpit table and full canvas package including bimini and cockpit cover. The layout below offers two generous double cabins plus a convertible saloon berth, along with two heads, making her ideal for cruising with family or friends in comfort and privacy.

She benefits from significant practical upgrades including 450W of solar, Raymarine Axiom+ chartplotter (2025), gas pipe replacement (2025), and professional engine servicing (October 2024). Having been regularly lifted ashore when not in use and supported by a full maintenance record, she is ready to step aboard and sail away.

REMARKS

Reverie is a particularly well-travelled and well-proven example of the popular Sun Odyssey 41DS. Having cruised extensively through the Western and Eastern Mediterranean before settling into enjoyable seasonal use in Greece, she has demonstrated both capability and reliability. Her two-cabin layout provides generous space for owners with occasional guests, while the twin-wheel cockpit and furling sail plan make her easy to handle as a couple. With regular professional servicing and sensible upgrades, she offers straightforward ownership and is well prepared for further island cruising.

LAYOUT

The layout provides a forward guest cabin with adjacent heads, and a spacious owners' double cabin with en-suite heads. The saloon features a hydraulic adjustable table, allowing conversion between dining and lounging space, as well as additional sleeping when required. Wood-effect flooring and light finishes create a bright, practical interior well suited to extended stays aboard.
