Remarks :

This well-maintained 2006 Jeanneau sailing yacht is presented in excellent condition and is a credit to her meticulous owners, who have cared for and continually upgraded the vessel since purchasing her in 2015. The boat has benefited from regular professional servicing, thoughtful improvements, and careful seasonal maintenance, including annual engine servicing and winterisation; professional polishing of the topsides, superstructure, and cockpit every season; and consistent winter storage ashore since 2015.

Significant upgrades include new standing rigging (2019), a Harken MKIV genoa furling system (2020), new mainsail and genoa (2017), updated Raymarine autopilot systems, AIS transponder installation, and replacement cockpit canvas including sprayhood, wheel cover and halyard bags (2020). The vessel is also equipped with a Gori folding propeller, Eberspacher diesel cabin heating, a solar charging system, and a comprehensive navigation package, including radar, chartplotter, and AIS.

Her spacious and practical interior offers comfortable accommodation for up to seven across two cabins and the saloon, complemented by a well-equipped galley and an owner-version heads compartment with a separate shower.

On deck, she features quality Harken deck hardware, teak cockpit seating, a walk-through transom leading to a sugar-scoop bathing platform, and a well-arranged cockpit designed for both cruising comfort and efficient sailing.

This yacht has clearly been cherished and carefully maintained by conscientious owners, making her a turnkey and well-specified example, ideally suited for coastal cruising or extended passages.
