Remarks :

Queen Anna is a 2008 Bavaria Sport 37 — a well-proportioned twin-engine sports cruiser built by Bavaria Yachtbau GmbH at Giebelstadt, Germany, and powered by twin Volvo Penta 5.7GXi stern-drive petrol engines. Now offered for sale in good overall condition, she has been carefully looked after by her current owner and benefits from a recent engine service, new domestic and starter batteries, and a full antifoul and anode renewal completed in April 2025.

The Bavaria Sport 37 is a purposeful design that combines the performance of a planing hull with a well-appointed two-cabin interior and a practical cockpit well suited to day cruising and coastal passages. Queen Anna is currently berthed in the Ionian and is ready for the coming season.

BROKER'S REMARKS

Queen Anna is a practical and well-found sports cruiser that will appeal to a buyer looking for genuine twin-engine performance combined with comfortable accommodation for a couple or small group. The Bavaria Sport 37 is a proven platform and this example has been kept in good order, with sensible maintenance carried out on a consistent basis — including an engine service in April 2026 and a full antifoul and anode renewal in April 2025.

The two-cabin layout works well for a couple with guests, and the cream leather interior gives the motor boat a clean, well-maintained feel. The cockpit is practical and well-suited to day use and coastal passages, with a hot and cold shower, cockpit table, and ample locker space. With planing speeds available from the twin 320hp Volvo Penta engines, she is capable of covering ground quickly when conditions permit.

A sensible and practical package for the buyer who wants a capable sports cruiser in a well-connected Ionian base. Early viewing is recommended.

Accommodation :

ACCOMMODATION

Queen Anna offers comfortable two-cabin accommodation suited to a couple or small group. The interior is finished in cream leather upholstery with cream curtains and teak and holly flooring, creating a warm and welcoming environment. Headroom is approximately 2m throughout.

LAYOUT

The layout comprises two cabins — each offering a double berth, or configured as twin plus sofa — with a central saloon featuring a convertible table. A single heads compartment is fitted.

DOMESTIC

The galley is equipped with a two-burner electric hob, a paraffin burner, a gas grill with fitted barbecue platform, a twin stainless steel sink, an Isotherm compressor refrigerator with freezer compartment, and a separate cool box. Pressurised hot and cold water is supplied throughout, with hot water via engine calorifier and shore power immersion heater. A microwave is fitted. The heads compartment is equipped with an electric flush toilet and shower. Air conditioning is provided by a stand-alone portable unit. Entertainment includes a Blaupunkt CD stereo, two new flat-screen televisions, and a TV aerial.

HISTORY

Queen Anna was built by Bavaria Yachtbau GmbH in 2008 (hull serial DE-BAVS37G5E808) and supplied new in Italy through Nauticom S.p.A. to Palladio Leasing S.p.A., with Italian IVA at 20% charged on first supply. The motor boat was subsequently purchased by her current owner, Roland Consten of Porta Westfalica, Germany, from Righetto Ivo of Torre di Mosto, Italy, in April 2018 at Lignano Sabbiadoro, at which time the engine hours stood at approximately 270 hours on each engine.
