Finishing 3rd in her class at cowes week and attaining several other honours this boat is ideal for fast and shorthanded sailing.

All lines lead to aft to the cockpit allowing for her to be sailed single handed and she has a full compliment of navigation and radar equipment. Penultima also comes with several Kevlar sails to give you that edge in a race.

The sunfast 32 sleeps 6 comfortably she has a double berth in the forward cabin as well as a double in the aft cabin and the saloon also makes a double berth .
