Numerous modifications include an added aft deck with carbon reinforcements, an integrated fridge in the cockpit box for fish, storage boxes in the engine compartment and cockpit, a refitted and reinforced flybridge arch, rod holders, and winch and reel mounts. Two remote-controlled projectors.

All rigging is recent. All window and porthole seals have been replaced.

3 bilge pumps + seawater pump. Batteries (2018).

Hull hydro-polished and epoxy treated. Full electronics: Garmin GPS (2017), 2 fixed VHF (ASN ?&acirc;&#130;&not;? AIS), 1 portable VHF. 8-person life raft serviced.

Consumption at 22 knots = 2 x 30 l
