The enclosed head compartment with a marine toilet and wash hand basin is situated to starboard between the saloon and the forward cabin.

L -shaped galley to port aft of the settee with a "Flavel" two burner gas cooker, grill and oven, cool box and stainless steel sink with pressurised hot water supplied by gas water heater

The aft cabin is aft of the centre cockpit and comes complete with two single berths, hanging locker, shelf, opening portholes and good engine access.
