This 1997 UK-built, fibreglass-hulled commercial fishing vessel, registered in Swansea as *SA 524 Billy Joe*, offers a robust and well-equipped platform for inshore and nearshore fishing. It is designed for versatility, accommodating a range of fishing operations including potting, small-scale trawling, and shellfish harvesting. With bilge keels and a single-screw Gardner Diesel 6LXB engine producing approximately 150hp, the vessel ensures stability and reliability in diverse conditions. The vessel's forward hold, accessed via a secure deck hatch, is optimised for catch storage, while the Blair winches on the foredeck enhance operational efficiency. The wheelhouse is well-appointed, featuring seating for both captain and mate, heating for comfort during year-round operations, and a range of navigational and safety electronics. This vessel is an excellent choice for professional fishermen seeking a proven, capable, and safety-oriented workhorse with a good licence. We are informed that the boat is a Cygnus GM33 but have been unable to verify this. Whilst the information provided is given in good faith, prospective purchasers must instruct their own agent or surveyor to independently verify the details.
