owner,&nbsp;She has been refitted and upgraded for offshore sailing&nbsp; and as such is ready to put to
sea immediately. She has had extensive work done including an engine rebuild in 2023. The engine is a Yanmar 2gm20
which runs well and has proved itself reliable. The comfort 30 was designed by Kenneth Albinsson who based his design
on that of a Joker S30 designed by Rolf Magnusson and this particular boat was built in 1978 by Robertsons in Scotland
as an improvement to the Albin Ballard, she has&nbsp;the same hull design but a deeper, higher aspect ratio, a
lead keel and a semi balanced rudder for improved manoeuvrability and performance. The comfort 30 is the perfect boat
for an adventurous spirit looking for a reliable sailing boat on a budget.</span></p>
