Its clean lines, generous space, and advanced design features embody the ideal cruiser for coastal exploration, extended voyages, or charter use.

On deck, its user-friendly layout and modern rigging systems allow for effortless handling, whether sailing solo or with a crew. The expansive cockpit, dual helms, and innovative fold-down transom seamlessly integrate performance and relaxation, making this yacht as comfortable under sail as it is at anchor.

Its owner has extensively customised this model to withstand the harshest conditions and excel on long-range voyages. This boat has journeyed across Europe and America multiple times, showcasing its remarkable capabilities. Among its standout features is a redesigned cockpit providing comfortable space and all-weather enjoyment. It has a safe steel structure covered by polycarbonate sheets, providing a 365-degree view and superior protection against wind and water. Additionally, it boasts multiple sets of sails and a robust aluminium companionway with netting, enhancing both versatility and safety.

This boat is exceptionally equipped for high-seas sailing worldwide and is ready to go.

This boat has been modified while respecting the original railing locations, potentially allowing it to return to its original factory condition. However, the cockpit's protective design and functionality allow for a large solar panel area with access to the boom, providing the opportunity to observe the mainsail's behaviour under sail. These are unexpected qualities for this Oceanis model. Visibility is remarkable, and we were pleasantly surprised by the ability to adjust ventilation and protection.

What truly sets this model apart is its versatile 4-cabin layout, tailored for accommodating larger groups without compromising privacy or functionality. This design ensures ample sleeping arrangements for up to ten crew while maintaining the luxury and spaciousness expected from a yacht of this calibre. The interior features two bathrooms with showers and electric toilets. The kitchen has two gas burners, three fridges, two sinks, an oven, a microwave and a custom faucet for purified drinking water.
