This Oyster 435 is a capable yacht with a good turn of speed that is equally at home exploring local waters and venturing further offshore. Its spacious cockpit and well balanced feel under sail combined with its spacious accommodation, creates a comfortable, practical cruising yacht, suitable for extended periods on board. New standing rigging 2018, running rigging 2018-2023, gas hoses 2024 and new batteries 2022. This Oyster 435 is one of a limited number designed and built with a coachroof rather than the deck saloon style of other Oyster Yachts.

Accommodation :

Forward cabin with V berths with an infill cushion to convert to a double berth, newly upholstered with storage under. Hanging locker, portlights and opening deck hatch. Door leading through to passageway, with to starboard, a two tier bunk cabin with portlights and a deck hatch and to port, the heads. Door through to the spacious saloon with a recently upholstered L shaped settee to port with a dining table and bench seat to starboard. Full size forward facing chart table to port with swivel seat, galley to starboard.

Door aft to port to the double berth cabin with fixed portlights and an opening portlight to the cockpit, vanity unit with a sink and storage, access to engine.

Door aft to starboard, to aft storage area with engine access, circuit breakers and tiller arms, also with access from cockpit locker.

Further information

This Oyster 435, hull number 15, is one of a very limited number designed and built with a coachroof rather than the deck saloon design of other Oyster Yachts. Design option at build of a retrousee stern. as with 'Promise' or with a counter stern.

Oyster Yachts launched 64 Oyster 435's in a 12 year production run from 1983 to 1995 and at one time was marketed as an Oyster 42.

'Promise' has been very lightly sailed in past few years.

Hull last antifouled, polished and new anodes fitted October 2024.

2021, Perkins 4.108 engine removed and professionally rebuilt.

The following work was carried out,

Strip engine, check and fit new liners to block, polish crank, overhaul head, rebuild engine using parts listed, test and run.

Pistons and liners
Rings oil and filters
Head set conversion set
Inlet valves exhaust valves guides springs
Water pump
Front seal and rea seal
Starter motor overhauled
Repair and check cooler
Injectors overhaul
fuel pump overhaul

2021 prior to engine being re-fitted, engine room was painted and new soundproofing installed

Warm air cabin heating hoses and exhaust are fitted but heater unit was removed as did not operate. A new unit could easily be fitted

The following instruments no longer function but have been left in place to avoid unsightly and unnecessary holes at the chart table.
