Remarks :
This 2003 Wauquiez Pilot Saloon 40 has been meticulously well maintained and has been laid up ashore every winter. She is powered by a well maintained shaft driven Volvo 55hp diesel engine with low engine hours. Her layout consists of a large owners cabin aft with en-suite, raised deck saloon (giving an excellent view of the outside world), linear galley and visitors cabin forward with en-suite. Her inventory includes, fully battened mainsail with single line reefing, lazy bag, furling genoa, spinnaker, electric windlass, electric winch handle, chart plotter, heating, davits, dinghy, outboard and a lot more. "Galeforce" has had light use from new and is in excellent condition. Viewing is highly recommended.

The saloon is bright and airy with excellent all round visibility, helped by her large pilothouse windows and opening hatches. The large folding saloon table is to starboard on a raised area and is surrounded by a very comfortable U-shaped settee. LED lighting. There are also two removeable stools at the port side of the table.

The Linear galley to port comes complete with a large work top space in synthetic marble twin stainless steel sinks, hot and cold pressurised water, two burner gimballled gas cooker with oven, 12v 80L refrigerator with lateral opening, cool box with refrigerator fitted with 12V compressor - Isotherm
Opening hatch above galley
Solenoid for gas valve
Waste bin
Galley fresh seawater pump
Numerous lockers to accommodate complete dinner service, cups, glasses
Kitchen utensils, cutlery caddy, pots pans, kettle, toaster, table mats, cutting boards etc.,

Large technical area to starboard for pumps, piping etc.

The forward facing chart table is located to port (aft of the galley) comes complete with book rack/electronic panel and electrics. Navigators seat with locker, reading light above chart table, cigarette lighter type 12v plug, inverter to charge phone/watch/ipad etc.

Wet locker opposite to starboard beside the companionway steps.

The master cabin is aft and has a large centre-line (island) double berth with lee clothes and with access from either side. Double density foam mattress with bed linen duvet pillows, cushions. Hanging locker, various storage areas, and large lockers under the berth. Two reading lights with LED ceiling lights, opening deck hatch and engine access.

The owners en-suite comes complete with electric quite flush marine W.C. wash basin and a separate shower cubicle. Holding tank, LED lights, towel hook, bath and hand towels;

The forward guest cabin comes complete with a large double berth, large locker underneath. Bed linen, duvet pillows, and cushions. Hanging locker, Various storage areas, large opening deck hatch, port hole with curtain
2 x reading lights with LED bulbs

This cabin also has its own en-suite with marine W.C. wash hand basin and shower. (hot and cold). Holding tank, opening deck hatch, port hole with curtains, LED lights, towel rail, bath and hand towels

Eberspacher D5L - 6 outlet hot air heating (saloon, cabins and heads);

There is ample storage space throughout.

G.R.P. hull with polyester and vinylester resins. Structural ribs, stringers, and bulkheads are glassed to the hull and deck.

GRP / Balsa sandwich deck, bonded to the hull with polyurethane adhesive and with mechanical fastening. Moulded ceiling liners with padded slats for a better insulation and easy maintenance;
