This particular yacht benefits from a range of recent upgrades, including new sails (2021), standing rigging replacement (2022), modern navigation electronics, and a twin-panel solar system for extended autonomy. The three-cabin, two-heads layout provides generous accommodation ideal for family cruising or liveaboard use.

The Oceanis 393 offers a three-cabin, two-heads configuration with a spacious and well-lit saloon. The owner's cabin forward features a V-berth and en-suite head, while two aft double cabins share a second head to port. The central saloon includes an L-shaped settee with dining table and a linear galley to starboard.
DOMESTIC
The galley is equipped with a gas oven and hob, pressurised water, and a refrigerator. Adequate storage is provided for extended cruising. Ventilation is good throughout the yacht, with opening hatches and ports.
