This 1980 Colvic Atlanta 31 ketch is powered by a Thornycroft 35hp shaft driven diesel engine. Her inventory includes a small mainsail, furling genoa, mizzen, 2022 electric windlass, hot water, chart-plotter, log, depth, wind, auto-pilot, four berths and much more. She is fine solid motor sailer and is in good condition!

<strong>Accommodation :</strong>

Aluminium sliding door leads from the cockpit into the bright and airy <strong>wheelhouse</strong>

Wheel steering to port (2nd steering station in the cockpit)

Comfortable helm seat with a single seat behind it

Bench seat to starboard

2 x opening windows

Going forward and down two steps brings you to a <strong>dinette</strong>&amp;nbsp;to port (saloon table can drop to convert to a double berth)

2022 cushions and covers. Slide open windows in saloon and galley.

Saorview TV with omni-directional antenna

Linear <strong>galley</strong>&amp;nbsp;opposite to starboard with a 2022 Plastimo Voyager 4500 two burner cooker with grill and oven, portable 12V Coolbox, stainless steel sink with hot water via the engine.

<strong>Heads</strong>&amp;nbsp;is forward of saloon to port with a slide out sink, hot water and opening porthole Hanging locker opposite

Two single berths in <strong>forward cabin</strong>&amp;nbsp;with 2022 covers. Opening deck hatch and storage.

Foam/carpet covering the sole (floors)

Loads of lockers throughout.
