The vessel is powered by a Gardner 5LW engine; legendary for its efficiency and longevity; paired with high-grade components throughout. With a beautifully crafted cherry wood interior and practical touches like dual air conditioning units, full galley, and twin electric heads, this tug boat offers a highly liveable layout ideal for extended cruising, liveaboard comfort, or unique expedition-style travel.
