The <strong>Gib&amp;rsquo;Sea 84</strong>&amp;nbsp;forward cabin has a V-berths that convert using an infill into a comfortable double bed, surrounded by lockers and shelving, and typically topped with an opening deck hatch for ventilation.
The <strong>Saloon </strong>has two bench settees (port and starboard) that can be used as single berths. Both berths have Leecloths fitted. A folding table in the middle makes social meals easy. It has a Radio/Bluetooth Player and a Triclicks cabin heater fitted.
The <strong>Aft Cabin (Starboard):
Strong> Offers an enclosed double berth, though headroom and shoulder space can feel tight under the cockpit&amp;mdash;particularly for broader or taller individuals.
