A cruising yacht quite similar in design to the NAJAD, HALLBERG RASSY, MOODY, WESTERLY, WAUQUIEZ models... The Swedish shipyard Puzzle Marin was created in the 1980s by former carpenters from the Hallberg Rassy yard. There are many similarities in the workmanship and attention given to the fittings, interior woodwork, and teak deck.

PUZZLE 36 - This 1985 quillard designed by architect Jürgen Särnén and built by the Swedish shipyard Puzzle Marin is very well maintained and equipped. Its design and dimensions combine performance under sail, comfort on board, and autonomy. Indeed, with a length of 10.93 m, a width of 3.5 m, and a comfortable headroom of > 1.9 m, this sailing yacht has nothing to envy from the habitability of more recent boats.
