This **2000 Beneteau Oceanis Clipper 331** combines comfort, safety, and ease of handling in a 10-metre sailing yacht, making it ideal for both coastal cruising and offshore passages (Design Category A).

Her bright and well-designed interior features two double cabins, a convertible saloon, a fully equipped galley, and a complete head. Designed by Groupe Finot, she offers excellent stability and comfort under sail, maintaining the perfect balance between performance and onboard liveability.

Powered by a Volvo Penta 2030 (25 HP), she is equipped with furling sails, a full suite of navigation electronics (GPS, autopilot, depth sounder, log, anemometer, VHF), and practical deck gear including bimini, sprayhood, cockpit table, cushions, and cockpit shower.

A reliable and well-maintained cruising yacht, ready to be enjoyed immediately.

Accommodation :

The **Oceanis Clipper 331** offers a bright and comfortable interior layout with **2 double cabins** and a **convertible saloon**, providing up to **6 berths**. The galley is fully equipped with a refrigerator, oven and sink, while the saloon provides generous seating around a folding table. There is **1 head with shower** and **pressurised hot and cold water**. Ample storage and ventilation make this yacht ideal for extended cruising.

Mechanical :

Powered by a **Volvo Penta 2030 (25 HP)** diesel engine, shaft drive with a three-blade bronze propeller. Fuel tank capacity approx. **70 litres**, cruising speed 6–7 knots, top speed around 8 knots.

The rig is a **Bermudan sloop**, with roller furling genoa and mainsail, aluminium mast and boom, and two winches for easy sail

handling. Designed by **Groupe Finot**, the Oceanis Clipper 331 combines reliable performance with ease of use, making it an ideal cruiser for both coastal sailing and offshore passages.
