Propulsion and Performance

The sloop is equipped with a Vetus inboard diesel engine with a power of 13 hp. This two-cylinder engine is electrically started and has approximately 755 operating hours. The engine is equipped with a temperature gauge and tachometer, contributing to straightforward operation. Thanks to the diesel engine, the sloop is suitable for longer trips, resulting in a calm and stable ride. The draft of 60 cm allows for navigation in shallower waters, making the sloop versatile.

Technical Equipment and Safety

On board, there is a 12v electrical system, including a battery charger and voltmeter. The battery was renewed in 2025, contributing to the reliable operation of the electrical systems. The electric bilge pump provides extra safety while sailing. For mooring, the sloop is equipped with fenders and lines, and an anchor with a line is available for temporary mooring on open water.

The hull was fully painted in 2018, and in 2025, the underside was treated again with antifouling, and new anodes were installed. These maintenance activities contribute to the durability of the underwater hull.

Sailing Experience and Usage Possibilities

This sloop has been used for recreational sailing in the canals of Amsterdam and on lakes and ditches for years. The owner has had the boat since 2014 and has had annual maintenance performed, including taking it out of the water for inspection and cleaning. The sailing characteristics are characterized by stability, tranquility, and smooth steering, making the sloop suitable for both novice and experienced water sports enthusiasts.
