Everyone can bid until March 16, 2026.</strong></h3><h3>Spacious Layout and Practical Living Space</h3><p>Inside the Tukkervlet 960AK, the headroom of 1.90 meters is a notable advantage, providing pleasant freedom of movement. The layout is practical and focused on comfort, with a cozy dining area, a functional galley equipped with a refrigerator, freezer, and stove, and sleeping accommodations for a total of six people. Two fixed berths are supplemented with four additional sleeping places, making the ship suitable for families or groups who want to enjoy the water together.</p><p>The cushions have been recently reupholstered, contributing to a fresh appearance of the interior. The presence of a manual toilet and a 200-liter water tank makes staying on board suitable for multi-day trips. Although the ship is not equipped with a heating system, the interior offers sufficient shelter and comfort for the sailing season.</p><h3>Engine and Sailing Characteristics</h3><p>The Tukkervlet is equipped with a JMR RE4 four-cylinder diesel engine of 60 HP, with a cylinder capacity of 2600 cc. This inboard engine, electrically started, delivers a cruising speed of approximately 15 km/h. The engine is functional and equipped with essential instruments such as a fuel tank gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, and tachometer. The fuel tank has a generous capacity of 400 liters, providing a wide range.</p><p>Thanks to the electric bow thruster, maneuvering in harbors and narrow waterways is easy and controlled. The dual steering &acirc;#128;&#147; both inside and outside &acirc;#128;&#147; offers flexibility and makes sailing more comfortable under different weather conditions.</p><h3>Navigation and Electrical Equipment</h3><p>In terms of navigation, the Tukkervlet 960AK is equipped with a compass, log/speedometer, and VHF radio. Navigation lights are present for safe sailing at dusk or night. For relaxation on board, a radio and television are installed.</p><p>The electrical installation is complete with shore power connection, battery charger, alternator, inverter, and four batteries. A solar panel provides additional energy supply, contributing to autonomy during longer trips. The electrical systems operate on 220V and 24V, providing sufficient capacity for most equipment on board.</p><h3>Outdoor Equipment and Safety</h3><p>On deck, the Tukkervlet is equipped with a bimini for shade on sunny days, davits for possibly hanging a dinghy, a swim ladder, and a swim platform for easy access to the water. The guardrail and fenders provide extra safety and protection during mooring.</p><p>In terms of safety, there are two fire extinguishers, life jackets, a lifebuoy, and gas lockers at the rear. Although no bilge pump is reported, the equipment is further tailored for recreational use on inland waters.</p><h3>Suitable for Relaxed Sailing Pleasure</h3><p>The Tukkervlet 960AK is ideally suited for enthusiasts of classic steel motorboats who value space, stability, and a practical layout.
