Remarks :
This 1993 Hunter Legend, designed by David Thomas and moulded by Hunter Boats Ltd, is a well-maintained and versatile cruiser, ideal for coastal sailing and exploring shallow waters thanks to her bilge keels and self-tacking jib.
She offers comfortable accommodation for six with two double cabins, a spacious saloon, a well-equipped galley, and a separate heads compartment. The warm teak joinery, Propex cabin heating (new 2020), and pressurised hot water system ensure year-round comfort onboard.
She's powered by a reliable Volvo Penta MD2020 engine and benefits from a comprehensive electrical setup, including new batteries (2025), solar charging, and shore power.
Her rigging and sail handling systems are up to date, with recent upgrades including a Selden Furlex furling system and stackpack (both new 2024). The sail wardrobe is extensive, including a spinnaker, storm jib, and cruising chute.
Navigation and safety equipment are extensive and well-suited for confident cruising. Additional features include quality deck gear, full canvas covers, and an inflatable dinghy with outboard.
A well-rounded and capable cruiser, ready for her next adventure.

Accommodation :
Six berths with two double sleeping cabins separate from the main accommodation.
In the forecabin, V-berth with infill to form a double, beneath berth stowage and opening hatch to foredeck.
In the saloon, bench settee seating to port & starboard, these act as single berths. Saloon table with drop leaves.
Galley to starboard with a Neptune 2000 two-burner gas cooker with oven and grill, double stainless-steel sink, top loading cool box and ample storage in various lockers and cupboards.
Chart table aft to port with navigation equipment and electrical distribution panel.
Heads compartment aft to port with marine toilet, washbasin and shower.
Aft cabin to starboard fitted with a double berth and hanging locker .
