Equipment and Comfort:

This sailboat, designed by Bruce Farr, is very seaworthy and comfortable to sail. It offers all the necessary comfort with its 3 cabins, 2 bathrooms, a fully equipped kitchen, hot water, deck shower, Perfect for offshore sailing, it is equipped with a wind turbine and solar panels, a desalinator making the boat self-sufficient in water and energy.

Recent electronics

Cockpit: large cockpit with recent dodger and bimini for optimal protection.

Rear arch: accommodating solar panels, wind turbine, a dinghy with engine (3.5 HP, 4-stroke).

Engine: Perkins Prima 60 hp, maintained annually, stuffing box changed in July 2024.

The boat has had two owners and has always been well maintained. Stable and reliable, the Oceanis 440 is ready to sail, tested in the Mediterranean and Atlantic. The owner reluctantly parts with his boat for reasons of age.
