Saluki Cabin Sailboat from 1974 €“ Compact and Functional Sailboat for Inland Waters

General Characteristics of the Saluki Cabin Sailboat

The Saluki cabin sailboat, built in 1974, is a polyester sailboat with a length of 6.20 meters and a width of 2.00 meters. With a draft of 90 centimeters and an air draft of 8.50 meters, this yacht is suitable for use on inland waters, lakes, ponds, and rivers. The boat is designed for recreational use and has been used for pleasure cruising and vacations over the past 25 years. The owner describes its use as a kind of floating caravan, indicating a practical and functional layout for multi-day trips.

Interior and Accommodation

Inside, the yacht offers a headroom of 1.20 meters, which is typical for a boat of this size. There are four fixed berths available, distributed throughout the cabin. The accommodation is equipped with mattresses and a stove, allowing for simple meals to be prepared on board. There is no toilet facility. The interior space is compact but designed for efficient use of the available space.

Hull and Construction

The hull is made of polyester, a commonly used material in yacht building due to its low-maintenance properties. The unique feature of the ship is that the superstructure is made of aluminum. According to the owner's statement, there are no signs of osmosis. The boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2024. The antifouling treatment dates from 2021.

Sail Plan and Rigging

The sail plan consists of three sails: a mainsail, a jib, and a storm jib. The foresail is equipped with a furling system, which simplifies reefing and handling of the jib. The mast is made of aluminum, and there is one mast present. This configuration is suitable for recreational sailing on inland waters and offers sufficient flexibility in changing weather conditions.

Motorization

Propulsion is provided by an outboard motor from the brand Suzuki, type F5, with a power of 5 hp. The motor has one cylinder and runs on gasoline. The fuel tank has a capacity of 10 liters. According to the owner's statement, the motor is operational. This configuration is suitable for a boat of this size and provides sufficient power for maneuvering in harbors and on calm inland waters.

Equipment and Deck Gear

On deck, the boat is equipped with a sprayhood, fenders and lines, and a swim ladder. This equipment contributes to the comfort and safety on board. There is one anchor available.

Suitability and Use

With its dimensions and equipment, this cabin sailboat is suitable for use on sheltered waters. The boat has been used for recreational purposes over the past decades, including vacations and day trips. The combination of simple accommodation, functional sail plan, and outboard motor makes the yacht suitable for sailors looking for a compact and accessible boat for domestic waterways.
