General Overview of the Fury 425

The Fury 425 is a polyester motorboat of the outboard type, built in 1975. Construction and Materials

The hull of the Fury 425 is made of polyester, a commonly used material in recreational boating due to its strength and relatively low maintenance. The boat features a double bottom, which aids in drainage and buoyancy. According to the owner, the boat has been tested for unsinkability in rough seas, indicating its structural properties.

Motorization and Electrical Installation

The Fury 425 is designed for use with an outboard motor of more than 100 hp. The electrical installation consists of a 12V system with a battery capacity of 12 ampere. This is sufficient for basic onboard facilities.

Equipment and Comfort on Deck

On deck, the boat is equipped with a deck cover, outdoor cushions, fenders, lines, and a swim ladder. The boat is complete and functional. The seats have backrests that can be folded back, creating a lounging area over the entire interior space of the boat. Storage space is available around the inside of the hull, reducing the risk of losing items in the water. The boat accommodates a family of five and is designed with ease of use and visibility in mind, offering a 180-degree field of view from the steering position.

Safety and Storage

The boat is equipped with a lifebuoy. A bilge pump is not present. According to the owner, the boat has been taken out of the water every winter for storage and classic maintenance. The last antifouling treatment and the last time it was taken out of the water was in 2025.

Trailer Information

The boat comes with a road trailer with a license plate. The trailer was built in 1975 and measures 600 x 180 cm. The load capacity is 2,000 kg. The trailer is single-axle, unbraked, and tiltable, with a wheel size of 135x80 R13. There are 19 rollers to support the hull. The trailer is equipped with a winch and is telescopic, making loading and unloading easier. The construction is robust and practical to use.

Usage Purposes and Sailing Area

The Fury 425 has been used in the Mediterranean Sea, mainly for recreational boating, day trips, sporting activities such as water skiing, vacations, and weekend getaways. The boat has been owned by the current owner since 1984 and was actively used during the summer months until 2010. In winter, the boat was taken out of the water for storage.

Special Features

The boat has several features that contribute to comfort and safety on board. The double bottom ensures efficient drainage. The seating arrangement allows the interior to be transformed into a sunbed. The throttle and navigation system controls are within reach of the steering position. At higher speeds, the bow rises, which is typical for this type of hull. The boat is designed with a modern appearance and offers ample space for a family.

History and Memories

The owner has had the boat since 1984 and has spent numerous summers at sea with it. Activities such as underwater and line fishing, as well as trips to islands off the coast of Sanary-sur-Mer, are part of its usage history. These experiences illustrate the versatile nature of the Fury 425.
