The "Bali Open Space" Concept

This is the Bali 4.3's strongest selling point. The seamless integration of the salon and cockpit, achieved via the innovative tilting garage door-style transom, creates a massive, singular living area. This feature maximizes volume, light, and ventilation.

Solid Foredeck and Forward Cockpit

Unlike traditional trampolines, the solid composite foredeck provides a secure, all-weather lounging area. The integrated forward cockpit with table and sun pads offers an unparalleled social space, often cited by buyers as a primary reason for selecting the Bali brand.

Autonomy and Self-Sufficiency

Bali is known for equipping its vessels for extended autonomy, including robust tankage capacity and large refrigerator/freezer space (the "American fridge"). For cruisers looking to minimize shore stops, this is a significant advantage.

Engines and Maintenance

She is equipped with 2 x 57hp Yanmar 4JH57 and saildrives. Serviced and saildrive oil seals replaced every year by Yanmar engineers. We have copies on file.

Included is safety equipment for 10 persons: life raft, automatic life vest with belt. The most recent service renewal of the life raft occurred in March 2024.


