This 2007 (2008 model) Beneteau Antares 7 has been well looked after by her one owner from new and is powered by a spotless Nanni 155HP shaft driven diesel engine with only 786 engine hours. Her inventory includes a double axle braked road trailer (with an extra axle), two berths, depth sounder, boat speed, handheld VHF, marine toilet in a separate compartment, cockpit seats with cushions and more. This boat has been well minded and viewing is highly recommended.

Accommodation :

Access to the wheelhouse via a sliding door from the aft cockpit

2 x Forward facing seats with cushions in enclosed wheelhouse

2 x Windscreen wipers

Sliding windows on either side of the wheelhouse

Sink with pressurised cold water

Cool box

Two single berths can convert to a double berth in the cabin

Opening deck hatch in the cabin

Saloon table (which can also be used in the cockpit)

Separate heads to starboard with a marine toilet and opening porthole

Ample storage throughout.
