The hull underwent a <strong>complete sandblasting in 2018</strong>, ensuring its excellent condition. The <strong>sails</strong> and <strong>engine</strong> are recent, providing optimal performance.<h2>Technical Specifications</h2>This <strong>boat</strong> is <strong>Apocalypse 43</strong> an <strong>1985</strong> and registered in France on <strong>September 30, 1986</strong>. It measures <strong>13.07 meters</strong> in length. It is a <strong>sandwich construction in Kevlar and Iso resin</strong>, making it very strong <strong>osmosis</strong>.<h2>Engine and no risk of and Propulsion</h2>The <strong>engine</strong> is a <strong>Yanmar 33 HP</strong>, installed in the center of the boat under the saloon table. It was recently replaced and has only <strong>300 hours</strong> of operation. The propeller shaft includes a <strong>three-blade folding propeller</strong>.<h2>Sails</h2>

<strong>Mainsail</strong> fully battened and replaced in <strong>2018</strong>, barely used, new condition (32 m&Acirc;&sup2; with Harken cars).

<strong>Genoa</strong> on a furler, measuring 52 m&Acirc;&sup2;, replaced in <strong>2018</strong>, new condition, barely used.

<strong>Staysail</strong> on a furler, measuring 14 m&Acirc;&sup2;.

<strong>Light asymmetric spinnaker</strong> measuring 142 m&Acirc;&sup2; (textile luff).

<strong>Heavy asymmetric spinnaker</strong> measuring 92 m&Acirc;&sup2; (stainless steel luff).

The interior features a <strong>central saloonwith a folding table and a large chart table with <strong>electronics</strong> (computer with digitized nautical charts, radar, VHF, B.L.U, depth sounders, and various navigation instruments).The galley is complete with a <strong>convection oven</strong>, a <strong>refrigerator</strong>, <strong>hot and cold water</strong>.There are <strong>3 cabins</strong>: a forward double cabin with a sink, an aft double cabin, and a single navigation cabin.
