Onedin 700 â: € “ Polyester Motorboat from 1974 with Outboard Motor and Trailer<The Onedin 700 is a polyester motorboat from 1974 with a length of 7 meters and a width of 1.72 meters. This boat is suitable for use on inland waters such as canals, lakes, ponds, and rivers. Thanks to its flat bottom and compact size, the Onedin 700 is maneuverable and suitable for both day trips and short stays on board. The boat is registered with the RDW.<h3>Dimensions and Layout</h3>With a draft of 30 cm, the Onedin 700 is suitable for shallow waters. The interior headroom is 1.60 meters, which is sufficient for seated comfort and limited mobility. The boat has two fixed berths and two additional berths, allowing up to four people to stay overnight on board. The accommodation includes a simple kitchenette with two gas burners on a gas bottle, an electric water pump for the tap, and a manual toilet with direct discharge to open water.<h3>Engine and Performance</h3>The boat is equipped with a Yamaha outboard motor from 2015 with a power of 50 hp. The motor has two cylinders, electric start, and a fuel consumption of approximately 2 liters per hour. The motor has 259 operating hours and is suitable for cruising speeds of about 12 km/h, with a maximum speed of approximately 25 km/h. The fuel tank has a capacity of 50 liters. The boat features a 12V electrical system with alternator, battery charger, voltmeter, shore power connection, and a solar panel. There is one battery with a capacity of 42 Ah.<h3>Navigation and Equipment</h3>The Onedin 700 is equipped with various navigation instruments, including a depth meter, GPS, chart plotter, compass, log/speedometer, wind meter, and a VHF radio. Navigation is supported by a Standard Horizon system with C-MAP chart. For anchoring, there is one anchor with line attachment. An anchor winch is not present, cockpit tent, tarpaulins, cockpit table, swim ladder, fenders and lines, and a guardrail. The cockpit is self-draining, which contributes to safety and ease of maintenance. For emergencies, there is a lifebuoy on board. The electric bilge pump ensures the removal of any water that may have entered.<h3>Trailer and Transport</h3>A road trailer with a license plate is included with the boat. This trailer is from the year 1992, has a load capacity of 1200 kg, and is braked. The trailer is equipped with six rollers, a trailer winch, and one axle. This makes transporting and launching the boat relatively easy.<h3>Maintenance and Use</h3>The last antifouling treatment took place in 2020. According to the records, the boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025. No signs of osmosis have been detected. The hull is made of polyester and has a flat bottom, which contributes to stability on calm water. Steering is done via a steering wheel and is dual, meaning it can be steered from two locations. Accessories</h3>Various extras are included in the sale, including paint, engine oil, and antifouling. The boat has been used in the past for pleasure cruising, day trips, and short weekend stays, including in Friesland. The sink is equipped with an electric water pump that serves both the tap and the filling of the water tank for the toilet. The water tank has a capacity of 150 liters.<h3>Summary</h3>The Onedin 700 is a compact motorboat with basic amenities for short stays on board. Thanks to the outboard motor, electrical system, and navigation equipment, the boat is suitable for recreational use on inland waters. The included trailer makes it possible to easily transport the boat and launch it at various locations. The boat offers space for up to four people and is equipped with a simple kitchen and toilet facilities. Ideal for those looking for a functional boat for day trips or short vacations on the water.
