Bayliner Capri 1500 with 90 HP Evinrude Outboard Motor €#147; Year 1989

The Bayliner Capri 1500 is a sporty and compact speedboat of American make, built in 1989 by the renowned Bayliner shipyard. This fiberglass boat has a length of 4.50 meters and a width of 1.80 meters, making it suitable for recreational use on inland waters and sheltered coastal areas. With a draft of only 35 centimeters, the boat is agile and easy to maneuver, even in shallower waters.

Construction and Design

The hull of the Bayliner Capri 1500 features a V-bottom shape, contributing to stable sailing and efficient water displacement. This hull construction is characteristic of sports boats designed for speed and agility. The material used is fiberglass, a common material in recreational boating due to its strength and relatively low weight. The boat is registered with the RDW under number 37-38-YA. Documentation is available in the form of a registration certificate.

The boat is steered via a steering wheel, placed in the open cockpit. The steering position is outside, providing direct contact with the surroundings and a good overview while sailing. The boat is not equipped with a rudder, as steering is entirely via the outboard motor.

Motorization and Performance

The Bayliner Capri 1500 is equipped with an Evinrude outboard motor with a power of 90 HP. This motor has four cylinders and is electrically started. The motor is operational and provides sufficient power for sporty sailing or towing a water skier or wakeboarder. The fuel supply consists of a tank with a capacity of 24 liters, suitable for shorter trips on the water.

Although the year of manufacture of the motor is not specified, the serial number is known: J0407029. The motor is an important part of the boat's sailing characteristics and contributes to its performance on the water. The combination of the V-bottom and the powerful motor makes this boat suitable for fast sailing and recreational use.

Trailer and Transport Options

The Bayliner Capri 1500 comes with an unbraked road trailer. This trailer is equipped with a single axle and has a maximum load capacity of 500 kg. The trailer is not equipped with a license plate and is intended for short-distance transport or use on private property. The condition of the trailer is described as reasonable, indicating that it is functional for moving the boat.

Maintenance and Technical Condition

The boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025. No signs of osmosis were observed. The overall condition of the boat is described as reasonable, indicating that the boat is functional and suitable for use, considering the age of the vessel.

Suitability and Use

The Bayliner Capri 1500 is a compact speedboat suitable for recreational use on lakes, rivers, and other inland waters. Thanks to the powerful motor and light weight, the boat is suitable for sporty activities such as water skiing or fast sailing. The boat is easy to trailer and store, making it attractive for users seeking flexibility in their sailing area.

With its year of manufacture in 1989, this Bayliner belongs to the older generation of sports boats but still offers functional sailing characteristics for enthusiasts of classic speedboats.
