making this space ideal for relaxing or entertaining at anchor or underway. The internal upholstery is Aqua marine/teal fabric that looks like new. The yacht also benefits from Webasto diesel cabin heating with added to its cozy feel.

The galley, positioned aft to starboard, is well equipped for cruising, offering an ENO two-burner gas cooker with oven and grill, a top-loading refrigerator, a double stainless-steel sink with pressurised hot and cold water, and plentiful stowage for provisions and cookware. Hot water is heated by the engine and a 240V Immersion heater.

The heads compartment, aft to port, features a marine toilet, wash basin with pull-out shower, mirror, and locker storage for wet polies, etc, providing everything needed for comfortable living aboard.

With its clever layout, stylish finish, and thoughtful design, the Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 34.2 delivers a perfect blend of comfort and practicality—making it an excellent choice for couples or families seeking a capable and inviting cruiser for coastal and offshore adventures.

Deck & Cockpit Layout

The Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 34.2 has been thoughtfully designed to offer an excellent balance of sailing performance, safety, and comfort on deck. Her well-proportioned cockpit and clean deck layout make her easy to handle, whether sailing short-handed or with a full crew.

The cockpit is spacious and secure, featuring comfortable seating with teak-laid seats and sole, a large folding cockpit table, and easy access to all primary sail controls. The wheel steering provides positive and responsive handling, while the instrument console is well-positioned for clear visibility of navigation displays and engine controls. Deep cockpit lockers offer generous storage for fenders, lines, and cruising gear.

Access to the sea is excellent, with a walk-through transom leading to an integrated swim platform and stainless-steel boarding ladder, perfect for swimming or tender access. A stern shower with hot and cold water adds to the comfort for extended cruising.

The side decks are wide and uncluttered, allowing safe and easy movement forward. All control lines are led aft to the cockpit for convenience, and stainless-steel guardrails and handholds provide additional security underway. The foredeck offers ample space for anchoring operations, with an anchor locker and manual windlass.

The combination of practical design, excellent visibility from the helm, and well-placed controls makes the Sun Odyssey 34.2 a pleasure to sail and manage. Whether cruising inshore waters or exploring farther afield, her deck and cockpit layout deliver comfort, safety, and ease of handling in all conditions.

History & Construction

Built in 2000 to 2001 specifications, this Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 34.2 has a white GRP hull and decks with non-slip surfaces. It has teak-covered seats in the cockpit aft cockpit area. Wheel steering. Aluminium toe rails. Stainless steel stanchions, pulpit. Glass Sprayhood with full cockpit enclosure. Walk through the transom gate to the bathing platform. Self-draining cockpit. Has been out of the water since December 2024, hull polished, and anodes changed. She has been well looked after by the owner and she looks like new internally. The owner has unfortunately passed away and is being sold by his daughter.

Mechanical :

<p>Spars & Sails</p><p>This Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 34.2 has a Bermudan sloop masthead, deck-stepped rig with Aluminium Seldon mast and boom. It has stainless steel standing rigging that was new in 2016. All running rigging is led aft to the cockpit to make sail handling easy. It has a slab reefing mainsail and furling genoa with a Facnor furling system.

Winches:

 2 x Harken Self-tailing winches used for haylards and sheets.

Sails:

1 x Genoa, Dacron, Westway sails new 2015 condition good

1 x Mainsail, Dacron, age unknown, condition good. <p> Mechanical Systems</p><p>This Jeanneau has a single Volvo Penta MD 2030 diesel engine with a shaft drive to a 3-blade feathering prop. The engine has indirect cooling via a heat exchanger. The engine hours are unknown at this stage. The engine was last serviced in 2024 by the owner. We are aware that it has been rebuilt at some point in its lifetime. There is a 110-litre plastic fuel tank. It will cruise at 5 knots and has a maximum speed of 7 knots. </p><p>Electrical Systems </p><p>3 x 12-volt batteries (1 x engine + 2 x domestic), charging from the engine alternator and via 240v shore power system with ring main, immersion heater and INVAC battery charger.</p> </p>
