There are two batteries on board, and the system operates on 220V.</p><h3>Navigation and Electronics</h3><p>For navigation, the Piewiet 850 is equipped with a depth sounder, GPS, compass, and VHF radio. Additionally, there is a log, a 27MC radio, and a stereo system.
