The draft is 85 centimeters, making the boat suitable for shallower waters. The clearance height is approximately 2.50 meters, allowing the boat to pass under most bridges. Inside, there is a standing height of about 1.90 meters, providing sufficient freedom of movement in the interior.<h3>Interior and Sleeping Arrangements</h3>The layout of the boat is focused on comfort and functionality. Additionally, there is a battery charger, a 2500W inverter, and a shore power connection. The onboard instruments include a fuel tank gauge, oil gauge, temperature gauge, and tachometer. The oil gauge is currently not optimally connected.<h3>Steering and Sailing Characteristics</h3>The Motorboat 1200 features dual steering positions, meaning the boat can be controlled both from inside and outside. Steering is done via a steering wheel, and there is one rudder. The boat is maneuverable and offers a smooth ride, contributing to comfort during longer trips or when maneuvering in narrow waters.<h3>Equipment and Extras</h3>On deck, the boat is equipped with various equipment elements such as a manual anchor winch, two anchors with chain and line, davits, fenders, lines, a guardrail, a swim platform, and a swim ladder. There is a small tender available, a rowing boat mainly used for maintenance work. For safety, there is a lifebuoy, fire extinguisher, smoke detector, CO2 detector, and an electric bilge pump on board.<h3>Maintenance and Condition</h3>The boat was last taken out of the water in 2021, when antifouling was also applied. There are some known points of attention, such as leakage along two windows during rainfall and some unfinished finishing. Documentation of the boat is available and will be provided upon sale.<h3>Usage and History</h3>The current owner took over the boat from a family who built the superstructure themselves. The boat has been used for various purposes such as day trips, vacations, weekend stays, and even as temporary living quarters.
