???? General description

The Dufour 39 CC is a monohull cruising sailboat, built in GRP (polyester / fiberglass) by the Dufour Yachts shipyard (France).

It was designed by naval architects Alain Mortain & Yannis Mavrikios (version "CC").

The suffix "CC" means "Center Cockpit"; this type of layout often allows for optimized interior volume, and a raised cockpit with visibility and comfort.

It is a cruising-oriented sailboat, quite comfortable for outings at sea, coastal sailing, or longer trips depending on the equipment.

???? Main technical characteristics

Inboard engine about 50 HP; often a Diesel engine, transmission by Sail-Drive.

Tank capacity Fresh water ~ 350 L, fuel ~ 170-180 L depending on versions.

Interior layout & comfort

The 39 CC typically offers 2 double cabins + a convertible saloon, accommodating 6 7 people depending on the layout.

A bathroom, a marine toilet, kitchen (galley), and a convivial living space are present; making it a boat adapted; coastal or offshore cruising.

The central cockpit is an asset for safety and comfort at sea: better protection from the elements, good layout for maneuvers and life on board.

Behavior at sea & usage

The Dufour 39 CC is considered safe and stable, well balanced, with good marine qualities. Even in normal weather, it remains comfortable and maneuverable.

It can suit coastal sailing but also longer cruises; comfort, water and fuel storage capacity, and interior space make it a good compromise for a small crew or family.

The layout (central cockpit, spacious saloon, double cabins) makes life on board pleasant, even for several days at sea.

For whom / for what use

The Dufour 39 CC is aimed at sailors looking for a versatile sailboat:

for coastal cruises or weekends along the coasts,

for outings with family or friends, with good comfort on board,

for vessels;tour of Europe / Great holidays; if the equipment is well maintained.

It combines ease of maneuvering (simple rigging, central cockpit) and affordable living on board, for 4 6 people, or even a bit more. More information and photos on the site xboat.fr
