This specific model was built in 1995 and has a length of 12 meters and a width of 3.80 meters. The polyester hull provides a solid and low-maintenance foundation. With a draft of 1.10 meters and an air draft of 3.40 meters, the ship is suitable for various inland waters and canals. Everyone can bid until January 19, 2026.</strong></h3><h3>Interior and Accommodation</h3>The Princess V39 offers four fixed berths, arranged in a comfortable layout with a dining area, mattresses, and sanitary facilities. The accommodation features an electric toilet that does not discharge directly into open water, a shower, and hot water supply. For onboard comfort, there is hot air heating and air conditioning. The kitchen is equipped with a stove, oven, refrigerator, and freezer, making the stay on board suitable for longer trips or overnight stays.<h3>Engine and Technical Equipment</h3>This motor yacht is equipped with two Mercruiser 4.2 ES 320 diesel engines, each with a power of 320 hp. Both engines are from the year 1995 and have six cylinders. The engines are electrically started and operational. The fuel tank has a capacity of 600 liters, providing a wide range. The boat is equipped with various instruments such as a fuel gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, and tachometer. For extra maneuverability, there is an electric bow thruster. Installation and Navigation</h3>The electrical installation on board consists of four batteries, a battery charger, alternator, shore power connection, and a voltmeter. The onboard voltage is 12V. For navigation, the boat is equipped with a depth gauge, compass, and VHF radio. This equipment makes navigating inland waters clear and safe.<h3>Exterior and Deck Equipment</h3>On deck, the Princess V39 is equipped with a teak deck, cockpit table, cockpit tent, and exterior deck sails. There are fenders and lines available for mooring. The swim platform is fitted with teak, although it is indicated that this needs to be renewed. For anchoring, there is an electrically operated anchor winch with chain and anchor. The exterior cushions contribute to comfort during the stay on the aft deck.<h3>Maintenance and Condition</h3>The last time the ship was taken out of the water for maintenance was in 2022. In the same year, the antifouling treatment was carried out. No signs of osmosis have been detected. A known point of attention is the teak on the swim platform, which needs replacement.<h3>Usage and History</h3>The current owner acquired the boat in 2019 from a previous owner in Lemmer. Since then, the ship has been used for pleasure cruising on inland waters. According to the information provided, the boat has been used for recreational purposes and not for commercial activities.<h3>Summary</h3>The Princess V39 from 1995 is a polyester motor yacht with a length of 12 meters, equipped with two powerful Mercruiser diesel engines. The boat offers space for four fixed berths and is equipped with extensive facilities for a comfortable stay on board.
