Kilkruiser 710 Polyester Motorboat with Interior Steering and Overnight Accommodation

The Kilkruiser 710 is a motorboat with a length of 7.10 meters and a width of 2.90 meters. With a draft of approximately 80 centimeters and an air draft of 2.40 meters, this cruiser is suitable for various inland waters, lakes, ponds, and rivers. The boat is made of polyester, a material widely used in recreational boating due to its low-maintenance properties. The interior headroom is 1.95 meters, providing ample freedom of movement inside.

The boat features interior steering with a steering wheel and a single rudder. The steering position is located inside, making navigation in less favorable weather conditions more comfortable. The last time the boat was taken out of the water for maintenance and antifouling was in 2021.

Interior and Sleeping Arrangements

Inside the Kilkruiser 710, there are two fixed berths, along with two additional sleeping places. This makes the boat suitable for short stays or weekend trips with multiple people. The accommodation includes a dining area and a stove, allowing for cooking and dining on board. In 2023, new curtains were installed, and a new cooler was added, enhancing the comfort on board.

In 2024, the interior was further upgraded. The floor inside was renewed, as well as the kitchen countertop. The interior of the boat was fully painted, and the lighting and electrical installation were reinstalled and repaired. These modifications contribute to the functionality and appearance of the interior.

Exterior Equipment and Ease of Use

The exterior of the Kilkruiser 710 is equipped with a canopy, outer deck with new carpeting, fenders and lines, a swim platform, and a swim ladder. In 2022, a new swim platform was installed, making it easier to get in and out of the water. The canopy was replaced in 2024 with a new custom-made version, featuring extra zippers for improved accessibility, regardless of the boat's position.

The cockpit bench has been extended and fitted with new cushions, providing extra seating comfort while sailing or docking. The exterior above the gangways was fully painted in 2024. Some work is still planned, including refurbishing the wooden steering wheel and applying a new non-slip layer on the upper deck. The non-slip granules are already available.

Motorization and Technical Equipment

The Kilkruiser 710 is equipped with a Vetus inboard engine. This engine is suitable for use on inland waters and provides sufficient power for recreational use. In 2024, new batteries were installed, along with a trickle charger, enhancing the reliability of the onboard electrical system. All filters have been recently replaced as part of regular engine maintenance.

The boat has a shore power connection, which was renewed in 2022. This allows for the use of external electricity at moorings with power supply, making the stay on board more comfortable.

Conclusion

The Kilkruiser 710 is a polyester motorboat with interior steering, suitable for recreational use on inland waters. The boat offers sleeping accommodation for four people and is equipped with various amenities for a comfortable stay on board. In recent years, several components have been renewed or modified, including the interior, the canopy, the electrical installation, and the swim platform. Some areas still require attention, such as the steering wheel and the upper deck.
