The fuel consumption is around 3 liters per hour, making this boat an economical choice for day trips or longer fishing evenings.</p><p>With a clearance height of only 1.15 meters, this motorboat is extremely suitable for trips through areas with low bridges. The shallow draft of 40 cm and the flat bottom make it possible to navigate shallow waters and narrow ditches, making the boat ideal for exploration trips through rural areas or urban canals.</p><h3>Comfort and Ease of Use Onboard</h3><p>Inside, the motorboat offers a standing height of 1.10 meters. The fore cabin is long enough to lie down in, making the vessel suitable for overnight stays or longer fishing trips. Steering is done via a wheel on the outer deck, providing direct and clear control. The boat features a single rudder and is equipped with instruments such as a fuel tank gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, and tachometer.</p><p>The electrical installation consists of a 12v system, powered by an alternator and a solar panel. This allows for sufficient power for basic amenities during longer trips. An electric bilge pump provides extra safety on board.</p><h3>Equipment and Possibilities</h3><p>The exterior equipment of the motorboat includes a tarpaulin, fenders, and lines. A small anchor with chain and line is also present. The boat comes with ropes, three fenders, and a small anchor, making it easy to prepare for sailing. A trailer is not included.</p><p>This motorboat is ideally suited for pleasure cruising, day trips with the family, or quiet fishing evenings with a friend. The stable position on the water and practical layout make it an accessible choice for both novice and experienced water sports enthusiasts.
