With a length of 14.75 meters and a width of 4.49 meters, this vessel offers a spacious and well-thought-out interior, combined with solid sailing capabilities. The Oceanis 50 is built with a composite hull and has a draft of 1.90 meters, providing a good balance between stability and accessibility in various sailing areas.</p>Beneteau Oceanis 50 now in the online auction. Everyone can bid until March 16, 2026.</h3><h3>Interior and Comfort on Board</h3><p>The interior of this Beneteau Oceanis 50 is designed with comfort and functionality in mind. The boat features two spacious cabins with fixed berths, and the salon offers additional sleeping space by lowering the dining table. In total, there are four fixed berths and two extra, making the vessel suitable for families or two couples traveling together.</p><p>The living area is equipped with air conditioning and hot air heating, making the stay on board pleasant in both warm and cooler climates. The galley is equipped with a refrigerator, freezer, oven, microwave, electric stove, and an espresso machine. All kitchen necessities are present, as well as sheets, blankets, towels, and duvets, making the vessel ready for immediate departure.</p><p>The wet room features a shower and hot water supply. The toilet discharge is directly connected to open water. With a water tank of 565 liters and a waste tank of 90 liters, the vessel is suitable for longer stays without frequent stops.</p><h3>Sailing Performance and Motorization</h3><p>The Beneteau Oceanis 50 is equipped with an aluminum mast and two sails in reasonable condition. The electric anchor winch and bow thruster (currently with an electrical wiring issue) contribute to ease of use during docking and anchoring. The electric bow thruster provides extra maneuverability in harbors and narrow passages.</p><p>The inboard Yanmar 4JH4-HTE diesel engine with 110 hp and only 243 running hours provides sufficient power for motoring when needed. The engine starts electrically and is connected to a fuel tank of 235 liters. The electrical installation on board includes a battery charger, inverter, shore power connection, voltmeter, and a wind generator. Additionally, there is an Onan generator for extra power supply during longer voyages.</p><h3>Navigation and Safety</h3><p>For navigation, the vessel is equipped with an autopilot, GPS, chart plotter, radar, depth meter, log/speedometer, wind meter, compass, and VHF radio. This equipment makes the vessel suitable for both coastal and offshore sailing. Safety on board is enhanced by the presence of a liferaft, lifebuoy, electric bilge pump, and a self-draining cockpit.</p><h3>Outdoor Space and Dinghy</h3><p>The deck features a teak finish, which is not only aesthetically pleasing but also provides good grip. The cockpit is equipped with a cockpit table, bimini, and sprayhood, offering protection from sun and wind. At the rear, there is a swim platform with a swim ladder, ideal for recreational use at anchor spots.</p><p>The boat comes with a Goldenship dinghy with a hard bottom, including a Yamaha outboard motor. This makes it easy to go ashore from anchorages or make small excursions.</p><h3>Suitable for Long Journeys and Comfortable Living</h3><p>This Beneteau Oceanis 50 has previously been used for living and sea voyages, including a trip from Spain to Sicily. The current owner describes the vessel as a spacious apartment on the water, with plenty of storage space and suitable for longer stays.
