mast and a traditional gaff sail plan, consisting of a mainsail, jib, and storm jib. The brown Dacron sails enhance the nostalgic appearance of the ship, while the rope fender around it provides a robust and well-maintained finish. The cockpit is spaciously designed and equipped with a cockpit table, cockpit tent, and comfortable outdoor cushions, making the stay on deck pleasant, both while sailing and at anchor.</p><p>Inside, the Grundel offers a surprisingly spacious living environment with a headroom of 1.92 meters. The layout is practical and atmospheric, with a round seating area that can easily be converted into additional sleeping places. In total, there are four sleeping places available, two of which are fixed. The mattresses and cushions have been recently renewed, contributing to the comfort on board. The kitchen is equipped with a stove that operates on 220v, a built-in cooler, and an extra cooling drawer under the bench. The manual toilet has been recently replaced and is located in a separate space.</p><h3>Sailing Properties and Engine Performance</h3><p>The Grundel is equipped with an inboard Peugeot Indenor diesel engine of 54 hp, with four cylinders and an electric start system. The engine was professionally checked and maintained in 2025.

With a cruising speed of approximately 10 km/h and a maximum speed of 12 km/h, the ship is suitable for relaxing trips on inland waters. The fuel consumption is around 2 liters per hour, making the ship efficient in use. The fuel tank has a capacity of 60 liters, and the water tank holds 50 liters of fresh water.</p><p>The steering is done via a tiller in the open cockpit, providing direct control and an authentic sailing experience. The Grundel is equipped with a single rudder and leeboards, contributing to stability and maneuverability, even at lower speeds or in shallow water.</p><h3>Navigation and Electrical Installation</h3><p>In terms of navigation, the ship is equipped with a GPS, VHF radio, depth meter, speedometer, compass, and log. The navigation lights still need to be connected, as well as the GPS. The electrical installation consists of an alternator, shore power connection, voltmeter, and two batteries of 100 Ah each. The voltage on board is 12v and 220v.
