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Comfortable Layout and Practical Equipment

The presence of a sprayhood, cockpit tent, and cockpit table ensures that the stay on board remains pleasant even in less favorable weather conditions. Inside, there is a headroom of 1.60 meters, which provides sufficient freedom of movement for most passengers. Steering is done via a steering wheel, placed in the cockpit, which ensures direct and clear control. The boat is equipped with a manual toilet and hot air heating, which increases comfort on board during longer trips or cooler days.

Motorization and Performance
The Rescue Sloop 720 is powered by a 52 hp inboard diesel engine with four cylinders, built in 1996. The engine is electrically started and has approximately 1000 operating hours. The propulsion is via an Enfield stern drive, which ensures efficient propulsion and good maneuverability. With a fuel tank of 120 liters and an average consumption of about 4 liters per hour, this sloop is suitable for longer trips without frequent refueling. The maximum speed is about 15 kilometers per hour, which is more than sufficient for relaxing trips on inland waters, lakes, and rivers.

The boat is equipped with various measuring instruments, including a fuel tank gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, and tachometer. Electricity is supplied via an alternator and a 12v system with a Bosch generator and a 45 ah battery. This system meets the basic needs on board, such as lighting and navigation instruments.

Versatile and Suitable for Various Purposes
This sloop has been used over the years on various waters, from canals and ditches to lakes and rivers. Thanks to its robust construction and spacious layout, the boat is not only suitable for recreational use but also deployable for commercial purposes such as tours or rentals. The low clearance height of 1.20 meters makes it possible to sail under most bridges, significantly increasing the sailing possibilities.
