The boat is built with a robust steel hull, reinforced below the waterline with stainless steel plates, contributing to the durability of the underwater hull.

Layout and Living Space

Inside, the narrowboat offers a headroom of no less than 1.94 meters, providing a spacious feel and comfort on board. The interior is currently open to customization, making this boat particularly attractive to buyers who want to realize their own style and layout. Whether you dream of a cozy houseboat or a floating holiday retreat, this narrowboat offers a solid foundation to bring your ideas to life.

The aft deck features a wooden floor that needs replacement. This provides a great opportunity to redesign the aft deck according to your taste and intended use. Access to the engine room is located under this deck, and it is important to consider waterproofing during renovation to prevent rain infiltration.

Engine and Sailing Characteristics

The boat is equipped with a Lister inboard diesel engine with two cylinders, also from 1970. This classic engine is operational and offers a cruising speed of about 7 km/h, with a top speed of 10 km/h. The engine was checked in 2023, and the gearbox was also overhauled. Although the gearbox sometimes slips slightly, the drive system functions properly in practice for leisurely sailing on inland waters.

With a fuel tank of 100 liters, the boat is suitable for longer trips without frequent refueling. The electric bilge pump contributes to onboard safety, while the available anchor with chain ensures a stable mooring when desired.

Sailing Experience and Usage Possibilities

This narrowboat has mainly been used on canals and ditches, making it ideal for calm waters. The shallow draft of 40 cm and an air draft of 1.60 meters make it possible to pass under low bridges, making the boat particularly suitable for urban waterways and rural channels.

The current owner has used the boat for both pleasure cruising and living, highlighting the versatility of this vessel. The boat offers enough space and potential to be converted into a comfortable houseboat or a charming recreational vessel.

Technical Condition and Maintenance

The boat was taken out of the water for maintenance in 2023, during which an antifouling treatment was also performed. This contributes to the protection of the hull against fouling and corrosion. The hull is equipped with extra plates below the waterline, which is a significant advantage for the ship's longevity.

Although there are some points of attention, such as the aft deck and the gearbox, this narrowboat offers a solid foundation for further finishing and personalization. The available documentation, including a valid "carte de circulation," makes it easier to use the ship on French and other European inland waters.

Style and Character

The Narrowboat 1000 exudes the atmosphere of traditional English ship design, with a sleek hull and a functional layout that perfectly suits life on the water. The steel construction and classic engine block give the ship an authentic character that is hard to find in modern boats.
