Carter 37 – Classic Sailboat with Character and Potential
The Carter 37 is a sailing yacht with a rich history and a design that still appeals to enthusiasts of classic sailboats. Design and Construction
The hull of the Carter 37 is made of polyester and has a round bilge shape, contributing to the seaworthiness and classic silhouette of the ship. The tiller steering and single rudder provide direct control over the vessel, which is especially appreciated by sailors who enjoy a pure and direct sailing experience. The clearance height of 16 meters makes the ship suitable for both coastal and inland waters, provided the bridge heights allow it.

Inside, the Carter 37 offers a headroom of 1.90 meters, ensuring a comfortable living space. The layout is functional and focused on practical use, with a dining area, a manual toilet, a heater for warmth, and a kitchen equipped with a stove, refrigerator, and freezer. There are five fixed berths, divided between the cabin and fore cabin, making the ship suitable for families or small groups.

Sailing Performance and Experience
The Carter 37 is known for its sporty sailing characteristics. Thanks to the hull design and rigging, the ship is capable of achieving high speeds, making it attractive to sailors seeking a dynamic sailing experience. The boat is equipped with three sails, which are described as being in reasonable condition. The aluminum mast and manual anchor winch contribute to the classic appearance and easy handling.

The boat has been used at sea in the past and has proven itself as a capable vessel. The self-draining cockpit and electric bilge pump contribute to onboard safety, while the available navigation equipment – including AIS, GPS, and VHF radio – provides support for planning and executing longer voyages.

Engine and Technical Equipment
The Carter 37 is equipped with a Yanmar inboard diesel engine of 30 hp, electrically started. The engine is functional and provides sufficient power for harbor maneuvers and motor sailing in light winds. The electrical installation includes a battery charger, voltmeter, and shore power connection, facilitating onboard living, especially during longer stays in marinas.

Equipment and Possibilities
On deck, the boat is equipped with a sturdy guardrail, fenders, and lines, contributing to safety and ease of use. The anchor is secured with chain and line and is operated with a manual winch. The boat has a Belgian flag certificate and comes with full documentation, making it easier for a new owner to put the ship into use.

A Classic with Potential
This Carter 37 is a classic sailing yacht with character, suitable for sailors looking for a vessel with an authentic appearance and sporty sailing characteristics.
