The Liamer Vlet 650 is a charming and characterful steel motor yacht from 1980, built at the Liamer shipyard. With a length of 6.50 meters and a width of 2.45 meters, this vlet offers a compact yet surprisingly spacious sailing experience. Thanks to its flat bottom and shallow draft of just 50 cm, this vessel is extremely suitable for exploring shallow inland waters, canals, and narrow waterways where larger boats cannot go. The low clearance height of 2.30 meters allows it to pass under most bridges, significantly expanding its sailing possibilities.

Comfortable Layout and Practical Amenities
Inside the Liamer Vlet, there is a cozy and functional living space. The train seat in the cabin can be converted into a double bed, while the bow offers two additional sleeping places, ideal for children. The headroom of 1.85 meters ensures that most passengers can move comfortably within the interior. The kitchen is equipped with a stove, refrigerator, and sink with running water, making the stay on board pleasant for weekend getaways or longer trips. A manual toilet is available in a separate space, contributing to comfort while sailing.

The cockpit tent has been recently renewed and features zip-in screens, providing ventilation without insects. This makes staying on board pleasant even during warm summer nights. The floor has been recently replaced, giving the interior a fresh appearance.

Engine and Sailing Characteristics
The Liamer Vlet is equipped with a Yanmar inboard diesel engine (type @gm20) from 2005 with a power of 18 hp. This two-cylinder engine starts electrically and provides a cruising speed of approximately 9 km/h, with a top speed of about 11 km/h. Fuel consumption is low, with an average consumption of about 1 liter per 3 hours of sailing, making this vlet an economical choice for longer trips. The engine is equipped with an oil pressure and temperature gauge, contributing to a safe and controlled voyage.

The steering is done from the inside steering position with a steering wheel, providing sheltered and comfortable operation. Thanks to its compact dimensions and flat bottom, the boat is maneuverable and easy to handle, even in narrow waters or when docking. For those looking for a vessel that feels at home on both lakes and canals, this vlet offers an excellent balance between size and functionality.

Power Supply and Equipment
The Liamer Vlet is equipped with a solar panel, battery charger, alternator, and a 300-watt inverter, ensuring a stable power supply on board. The battery capacity is 165 ah, sufficient for lighting, refrigerator, and other electrical amenities during the stay on the water. Externally, the boat is equipped with an anchor with line, fenders and lines, and a practical cockpit tent that provides shelter from sun and rain.

Unique Character and History
What makes this Liamer Vlet special is not only its practical layout and ease of sailing but also its unique background. Only two examples of this model were built, giving the vessel a rare character. The current owner took over the boat from a couple who enjoyed sailing throughout the Netherlands for many years. In the winter of 2022/2023, the ship underwent a thorough overhaul: the hull was repainted in seven layers, and various updates were made, including the solar panel and cockpit tent.

Although the foredeck deserves attention again due to slight rust formation, this is mainly cosmetic and easy to restore with a new coat of paint. The swim ladder also has minor damage from a collision with the shore, which does not affect the functionality of the vessel.

Versatile and Inviting
The Liamer Vlet 650 is an inviting vessel for those looking for an authentic and practical motorboat for recreational use. Whether it's day trips, weekend getaways, or longer vacations on the water, this vlet offers comfort, character, and versatility. Thanks to the low clearance height and shallow draft, less accessible sailing areas are also within reach. The combination of a cozy interior, efficient engine, and rich history makes this
