This five-cylinder inboard engine, coupled with a Bravo 3 Z-drive, delivers a cruising speed of approximately 20 km/h and a top speed of about 45 km/h. With an average fuel consumption of 20 liters per hour and a fuel tank of 150 liters, the range is more than sufficient for longer day trips or weekend stays on the water. The engine has approximately 410 running hours and is electrically started. The combination of diesel technology and sporty sailing characteristics makes this boat suitable for both inland waters and rougher conditions, such as the Western Scheldt.</p><h3>Comfortable Layout and Overnight Possibilities</h3><p>The Triton 225 Cuddy is designed as a weekender and offers sleeping accommodation for two people in the cabin. The electrical installation includes a battery charger, alternator, inverter, shore power connection, and two batteries with a total capacity of 180 Ah. The onboard voltage is 12V and 220V, enabling the use of various electrical appliances. Instruments such as a fuel tank gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, and tachometer provide the skipper with good insight into the engine's status.</p><h3>Equipment and Safety</h3><p>The exterior equipment of the Triton 225 Cuddy is complete and functional. On deck, there is an anchor with chain and line, fenders, mooring lines, a guardrail, and a swim platform. The cockpit is self-draining and equipped with an electric bilge pump, contributing to onboard safety. A worn winter cover is included, as well as a convertible top frame that is no longer in use.
