The wastewater tank has a capacity of 200 liters, and the toilet discharge is connected to a closed system, contributing to environmentally friendly sailing.</p><h3>Motorization and Performance</h3><p>The Stijlsteven is equipped with a DAF 575 diesel engine with a power of 140 hp. This inboard engine with electric start offers a cruising speed of approximately 10 km/h and a maximum speed of about 15 km/h. The engine is operational and is powered by a 200-liter diesel tank. Propulsion is supported by a single rudder, ensuring direct and stable steering.</p><h3>Technical Equipment and Power Supply</h3><p>Technically, the ship is equipped with basic equipment including a tachometer, voltmeter, and a 24v electrical system. Two batteries provide power on board, supplemented by a solar panel for extra energy efficiency. For navigation, a GPS and VHF radio are available, facilitating sailing on larger inland waters. Safety is ensured by a lifebuoy, self-draining cockpit, and a manual bilge pump.</p><h3>Opportunities and Potential</h3><p>Although the ship has not been out of the water for maintenance since 2017, and there is overdue work such as painting and a hull inspection, the Stijlsteven 1900 offers a solid foundation for enthusiasts of classic ships.
