### Classic Design with Practical Layout

The motorboat 1100 is built with a steel hull and has an air draft of 2.65 meters, making it possible to sail under most bridges. The draft of 1 meter makes the ship suitable for various sailing areas, from rivers to lakes. Inside, there is a headroom of 2 meters, which contributes to the comfort on board, especially during longer trips.

The layout is practical and focused on comfort. The boat features a fixed sleeping area with a double bed, a dining area, a kitchen with a stove, oven, and refrigerator, and a manual toilet. The available heater provides extra comfort during cooler days, allowing the sailing season to be extended.

### Propulsion and Performance

The boat is powered by a Ford inboard diesel engine with a power of 70 hp, distributed over three cylinders. This engine, electrically started, offers a cruising speed of approximately 18 km/h and a top speed of about 20 km/h. This makes the boat suitable for leisurely trips where enjoying the surroundings is central. The electric bow thruster facilitates maneuvering in harbors and when docking.

The engine is functional and was last maintained in 2023, during which the antifouling was also renewed. The onboard instruments, including a fuel tank gauge, oil pressure gauge, and tachometer, provide the skipper with the necessary information while sailing.

### Electrical Installation and Equipment

The electrical installation on board is equipped with an inverter, shore power connection, and a voltmeter. There are three batteries present, and the system operates on 220v, which provides sufficient capacity for most electrical facilities on board. Externally, the boat is equipped with a canopy, offering extra protection against wind and rain while sailing or mooring.

For anchoring, there are two anchors with chain attachments available. The boat is sold including various accessories, an oven, and life jackets.

### Sailing Experience and Possibilities

What distinguishes this motorboat 1100 is the space on board. The generous layout makes it possible to comfortably accommodate multiple people, making the ship ideal for family vacations or longer trips. The fixed sleeping area and functional kitchen contribute to a pleasant living environment on the water.

The current owner describes the boat as a fine, spacious companion for family outings, with the freedom on the water being mentioned as the most valuable memory.
