**Admiral 25** is a classic Italian motor yacht with character and space. The Admiral 25, built in 1978 by the renowned Italian Admiral shipyard, is a classic motor yacht that combines style, space and seakeeping in a timeless design. With a length of 24 metres and a beam of 5.90 metres, this vessel offers an impressive amount of living space, both inside and out. The wooden construction contributes to the yacht's authentic appearance, while the equipment and amenities are geared towards comfortable stays on board, even for longer periods.

**Spacious layout and onboard comfort**  
Inside the yacht, the headroom of 2.06 metres is a notable feature, enhancing the sense of space and openness. The Admiral 25 offers eight fixed berths and three additional berths, spread across multiple cabins and living areas. This makes the vessel highly suitable for larger groups or families who want to enjoy a relaxing cruising holiday together. The accommodation includes various comfort-enhancing features, such as air conditioning, heating via a stove, and a fully equipped galley with hob, oven, microwave, refrigerator and freezer. In addition, there is a spacious dinette and a separate shower. The vacuum toilet is connected to a 1,000-litre holding tank, supporting an environmentally considerate stay on board. The freshwater tank has a generous capacity of 3,000 litres, contributing to autonomy during longer trips.

**Performance and propulsion**  
The Admiral 25 is fitted with two powerful MTU 12V 331 diesel engines, each with 12 cylinders and 1,360 hp. The engines are electrically started. The starboard engine is currently not operational, and the port engine requires attention to the fuel injection adjustment. The vessel offers a cruising speed of approximately 22 km/h and a top speed of around 30 km/h, making it suitable for both relaxed cruising and faster passages at sea. The fuel tank capacity is 10,000 litres, enabling long distances without frequent refuelling stops. The electric bow thruster facilitates manoeuvring in harbours and narrow waters. The onboard electrical systems are supported by a Kohler 11 kVA generator and a battery bank of 12 batteries with a total capacity of 230 Ah; the batteries and charger were recently replaced in 2024.

**Navigation and equipment**  
In terms of navigation, the Admiral 25 is equipped with radar, fishfinder, compass and VHF radio. These instruments make cruising on open water clear and safe. Onboard voltage is available in 12V, 24V and 220V, allowing the use of various electrical appliances. Externally, the vessel features a teak deck, bimini, cockpit table, exterior cushions, and a swim platform with bathing ladder. The hydraulic anchor windlass and two anchors with chain and line provide secure holding at anchorages. A deck crane (davit) makes it easy to launch the tender; a six-person Zodiac with a 40 hp Yamaha outboard engine.

**Cruising experience and possibilities**  
The Admiral 25 is designed for comfortable sea cruising and offers a stable ride, even in changing weather conditions. The spacious decks and the aft beach club area invite relaxation and social moments on board. Thanks to its layout and amenities, the vessel is suitable for a wide range of uses, from day trips and weekend stays to longer holidays on the water. The classic lines and Italian design give the yacht an elegant appearance that still impresses. Despite its age, the vessel has retained its charm and offers a unique cruising experience for enthusiasts of characterful motor yachts with a rich history.
