Baja 192 (2007) speedboat with MerCruiser 190 hp incl. road trailer

The 2007 Baja 192 is a compact, sporty speedboat designed for brisk day cruising, watersports and dynamic boating on inland waters. With a length of approx. 6.00 metres and a beam of 3.00 metres, this model offers a notably stable platform for its class, while the GRP hull contributes to a sleek look and practical ease of use. This Baja has been used for leisure boating and day trips, which fits the 192 concept perfectly: fast, agile and accessible, with onboard comfort for short outings and sunny afternoons on the water.

Performance and handling: 190 hp MerCruiser petrol inboard

The heart of this Baja 192 is a 2007 MerCruiser inboard petrol engine with 190 hp and six cylinders, with electric start. This setup is known for its direct throttle response and sporty character; exactly what matches Baja's DNA. With a stated top speed of around 75 km/h, this is a speedboat that not only gets on plane quickly, but also delivers convincing performance when you enjoy active driving. At the same time, the size remains manageable, making docking and manoeuvring in marinas and on busier inland waters pleasantly easy to control.

Steering is via a wheel at an outside helm position, providing an open, engaged boating experience. You sit close to the water with good all-round visibility; ideal for both relaxed cruising and more spirited driving. For monitoring the engine and voyage, the key gauges are present, including a tachometer, temperature gauge, oil pressure gauge and fuel gauge. This gives you continuous insight into the most important values while underway, contributing to controlled and comfortable cruising.

Fuel, range and practical use

The fuel tank has a capacity of approx. 140 litres. Combined with the efficient character of a 6-cylinder inboard in this boat class, this provides a solid basis for day trips, watersports sessions and longer routes on inland waters. The draft of about 1.00 metre makes the boat suitable for many common cruising areas, with sufficient margin for channels and harbours, while still retaining the sporty handling you expect from a Baja.

Comfort and deck equipment: ready for sunny days

On board, the equipment is geared towards comfortable day use. The boat is fitted with a bimini for shade on warm days, exterior cushions for seating comfort, and cover(s) to protect the boat when not in use. The swim platform with swim ladder makes it easy to swim, paddleboard, or get back on board after watersports. These are exactly the features that make a sport boat not only fast, but also versatile: drop anchor, jump in the water, then relax back on deck.

For safety and convenience, an electric bilge pump is installed. The boat was taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025, and no signs of osmosis have been reported.

Trailer included: flexible transport and easy launching

A major plus is that this Baja 192 is supplied with a Kalf road trailer (Belgian registration). The trailer is braked, has two axles, a payload capacity of 2,500 kg, and is equipped with a trailer winch. This makes transporting and launching much more accessible; especially if you like to switch between cruising areas or store the boat at home. For anyone looking for a speedboat with trailer, this is a practical combination: you are less dependent on a permanent berth and can plan your boating season flexibly.

Style and possibilities: sport boat for day trips and watersports

The Baja 192 is a recognisable sport boat with a performance-focused look and a layout that invites active use. Think fast runs across the water, an afternoon cruising with friends or family, or a spontaneous stop for a swim. Thanks to the combination of the MerCruiser 190 hp, the compact size and the included trailer, this is an attractive choice for buyers looking for a sporty GRP speedboat for inland waters, with the freedom to trailer easily and get on the water quickly.
