**Beneteau Flirt (1993)** – compact sailing boat  
The 1993 Beneteau Flirt is an accessible, practically laid-out sailing boat that is perfectly suited for a day of fun on lakes, inland waters and canals. With a length of 6.10 metres and a beam of 2.20 metres, this model offers a pleasant balance between manoeuvrability and stability, making it easy to handle for both novice sailors and experienced water sports enthusiasts. The 1.40-metre draft gives the boat a sporty sailing character and provides a direct, lively response at the helm, while the polyester hull contributes to a low-maintenance base for recreational use.  
This Beneteau Flirt has been used on inland waters and is known as a simple, easy boat to live with. That makes her interesting for anyone looking for a compact cabin sailboat that is quick to get ready to sail, causes little hassle in the marina, and above all invites you to head out on the water spontaneously.

**Dimensions, design and sailing feel**  
With her compact dimensions, the Beneteau Flirt is ideal for berths where space is limited, while still being large enough to sail comfortably with two people. The cockpit is arranged for relaxed seating, which suits the intended use: day trips and leisurely enjoyment on the water. Thanks to the combination of beam and hull shape, the boat feels predictable, and in shifting winds she is easy to trim. The aluminium mast and the straightforward rig concept keep everything light and manageable, which is especially convenient when hoisting and lowering the sails.

**Sail plan and performance under sail**  
The sail plan consists of a mainsail, jib and storm jib. This makes the boat versatile: from light-air sailing with the standard sails to increased control when the wind picks up, where the storm jib can provide extra security and balance. The condition of the sails is described as reasonable, offering a realistic starting point for a buyer who wants to sail immediately and potentially optimise later to personal preferences. Under sail, this type of Beneteau is generally lively and playful, with enough feedback for active helming, without becoming a complicated boat to sail.

**Electric outboard motor (2022)** – quiet and comfortable manoeuvring  
An attractive feature of this Beneteau Flirt is the electric outboard motor with electric start, with a stated output of 6 hp and year of manufacture 2022. In practice, electric propulsion mainly means calm manoeuvring, minimal vibration and a quiet experience in the marina and on tranquil stretches. This fits well with inland waters, where comfort and noise levels often matter more than high speeds. The motor is operational and one battery is included. For buyers who value a modern, quiet drive for harbour manoeuvres and short transfers, this is a clear plus.

**On-board comfort and overnight possibilities**  
Inside, the boat offers two fixed berths, making the Beneteau Flirt suitable for a simple overnight stay or a weekend away with minimal equipment. The boat is supplied with cushions, which immediately makes time on board more comfortable. It is a compact cabin sailboat primarily intended for day trips and light camping on the water. Anyone looking for a straightforward boat without complex systems will find a fitting concept here.

**Equipment, deck details and practical extras**  
On deck, a swim ladder is present, handy for a refreshing dip or for getting back on board easily after swimming. There is also an anchor with chain, which is practical for breaks in sheltered spots or to lie at rest during a day trip. Mooring lines are included, so the basic mooring equipment is on board.

**Maintenance indication and usage history**  
The boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025, and no indications of osmosis have been reported. The overall condition is described as reasonable, which fits a boat that has been used for what it was intended: accessible sailing and relaxed cruising on inland waters. Documentation in the form of a brochure is available, which is useful for anyone who wants to learn more about the model and the original

specifications.

### Who is this Beneteau Flirt interesting for?

This Beneteau Flirt is a logical choice for water sports enthusiasts looking for a compact sailing boat with a cabin, two berths and a quiet electric outboard motor. She suits buyers who mainly want to enjoy sailing on inland waters, with a boat that is easy to handle, offers comfortable cockpit seating and invites spontaneous day trips. Thanks to the complete, straightforward sail plan and the practical basic equipment, this is an attractive entry-level model in the world of Beneteau sailboats, with a clear focus on simplicity, sailing enjoyment and comfort on the water.
