This compact console boat needs no introduction, it has proven itself among fishermen and boaters of all kinds. Practical, lively with its 200hp engine, very seaworthy and comfortable thanks to particularly careful tuning, it has many assets.

Here in a highly optioned iteration, it features three sliding doors (two side doors, one cockpit door), a bow thruster, two swivel seats at the stern in addition to the bench. Additional options:

Anchor well, folding davit and electric windlass.

Rod holders in the gunwales, at the bow and stern (x6)

Stern live well with pump and drain.

Bathing platforms with stainless steel ladder.

Cockpit table.

Cockpit lighting.

40L fridge.

360° curtains.
