For sale: Beneteau Oceanis 300, a cruising sailboat well known for its balanced sailing qualities and versatility. Designed by the Finot naval architecture group, it features a hull from the same generation as the Figaro Solo 1 and the First 310, renowned for combining performance, stability and safety at sea.

The hydraulic lifting twin keel version is particularly rare. This configuration allows access to shallow anchorages and safe drying out while maintaining very good sailing performance.

This boat has benefited from careful maintenance and several important upgrades.
